In addition to societal changes, there are causes specific to the medical enterprise that contribute to medicine's disconnection from its underlying moral foundation. For example, advances in medical science and technology have improved the prospect of cure but has de-emphasized medicine's traditional caring function. Other contributions include the commercialization of medical practice, the growing preoccupation of some physicians with monetary concerns, and the loss of the sense of humility and humanity by certain practitioners.
